Fall 2008 Field Trial

Sept. 26-28, 2008

The Iowa Brittany Club extends an invitation to you to attend the Fall 2008 Field Trial held at Union County Ranch, two miles south and one mile west of Thayer, Iowa.

This trial is licensed by the AKC and recognized by the American Field and Amateur Field Trial Clubs of America. Your dog does not have to be registered in the Field Dog Stud Book to compete, but only dogs with FDSB registrations will be recognized as qualifying at this trial to run in American Field championships.

Parking and stake-outs are permitted in the main campground area and the area immediately north of the big pines. **ABSOLUTELY NO VEHICLES MAY BE PARKED AND NO HORSES STAKED OUT ON CRP GROUND.**

Unauthorized vehicles are not allowed anywhere on the course (including the breakaway areas). Failure to follow these guidelines could result in immediate loss of these grounds for any future field event. Parking is permitted on the concrete slab, but please leave room for others to get in and out.
