Fall 2018 Field Trial
September 28-October 4, 2018

The Iowa Brittany Club extends an invitation to you to attend the Fall 2018 Field Trial held at the Union County Ranch, two miles south and one mile west of Thayer, IA

This trial is licensed by the AKC and recognized by the *American Field* and Amateur Field Trial Clubs of America. Your dog does not have to be registered in the Field Dog Stud Book to compete, but only dogs with FDSB registrations will be recognized as having qualified to run in AF Championships. **NOTE: AFTCA now requires that dogs competing in amateur stakes wear colored collars corresponding to top or bottom dog in a brace, orange for top dog, green or yellow for bottom dog.**

HAY

Alfalfa/grass hay (approximate weight 60-65 pounds/bale) will be available for \$7/bale. Pre-orders will be accepted; any remaining hay will be sold on a first-come, first-serve basis. Send pre-orders to the field trial secretary along with your entries. Checks should be made payable to Bird Dog Ranch. (NOTE: You may reserve hay for both the Iowa and Hawkeye trials in the same order if you wish).

DIRECTIONS TO THE GROUNDS

From North, South, or East:

Take Interstate 35 to Exit 33 at Osceola and turn left (west) onto US Hwy 34. Proceed approximately 13 miles to Thayer. Turn south on county Hwy P-64. Proceed 2 miles to 210th St (gravel road). Turn right (west) and go approximately 1-1/4 mile. The field trial grounds will be on your right.

From the West:

On Interstate 29, take Exit 34 onto US Hwy 34 East. Go east approximately 95 miles to Thayer. Follow directions given above.

On Interstate 80: *State Hwy 25 is closed south of I-80 due to bridge construction.* Proceed to DeSoto and take Exit 110 onto US Hwy 169 South. Go south approximately 37 miles to the intersection with US Hwy 34. Turn left (east) and proceed approximately 1.5 miles to Thayer. Follow directions given above.

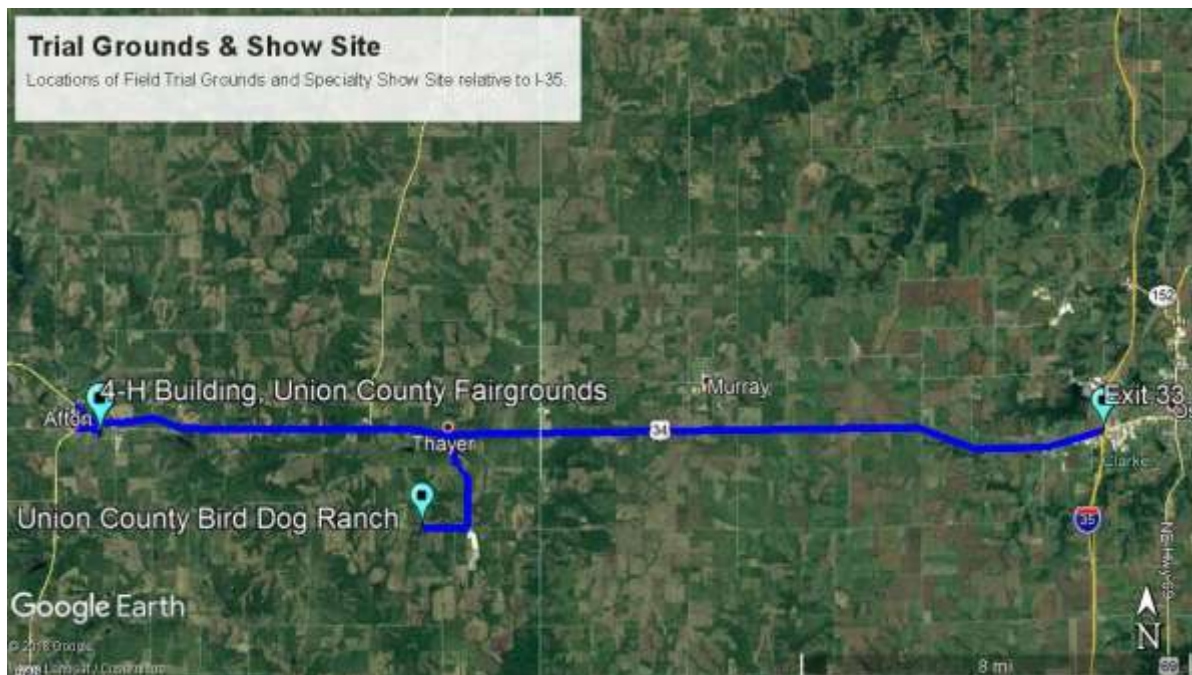
